"Junior Match Play was a perfect opportunity to exercise sportsmanship and practice proper attitude like no outbursts and racquet throws."



USTA Tournament Recap



On June 28th at MNTC, we had our first Adult NTRP 3.0–4.0 Tournament! We had an amazing turnout and so much interest that we couldn't even fit everyone in!

Big congratulations to our very own MNTC members who crushed it on the courts:

William – 4.0 Men's Champion Noah – 3.0 Men's Champion Brian – 3.5 Men's Finalist Jennifer – 3.0 Women's Finalist We also want to take a moment to address a common question we've heard:

"Why was 'someone' allowed to compete at that level?"

Here's how it works:

- All players must have a valid USTA NTRP rating to register for NTRP tournaments.
- If a player enters the 3.5 division, they officially have a 3.5 rating in the USTA system.
- We cannot—and are not allowed to—move a player based on community feedback or match performance.

NTRP ratings are updated annually by the USTA using verified match data. While we may feel someone plays "like a 4.0," NTRP ratings include a range (e.g., a 3.5 rating includes players from 3.01 to 3.50). That means two players with the same rating can perform very differently. A 3.49 might dominate a 3.01—and still, both are valid 3.5 players.
