
COACH TYLER MACY

Tyler Macy joined the Tribe men's tennis program as assistant coach in August 2025.

As an assistant coach at his alma mater, Gardner Webb, Macy helped lead the Runnin' Bulldogs to a 20-5 record. This was major because it was the program's first Big South Tournament Championship, and a spot in the NCAA Tournament! The program finished 2025 ranked No. 8 in the Carolinas Region and No. 75 nationally after earning its first national ranking earlier in the season. Gardner Webb produced both the Big South Freshman of the Year and Player of the Year.

Macy has nearly five years of experience as a director and tennis professional. He spent two years as the Director of Court Sports at the Statesville Country Club and the Rock Barn Country Club and Spa in North Carolina from 2022-24.

He spent nearly two years at the Atlantic Beach Country Club in Atlantic Beach, Fla. Macy began his tenure at Atlantic Beach as a tennis professional, before being promoted to the head professional in 2022. Macy started his career as the head tennis professional at Bloomington Tennis Center in Illinois in 2019.

Macy earned his degree from Gardner Webb in 2018 in business administration. In high school, he lead his team to a North Carolina State Team Championship. Macy also won an individual state championship in 2012 and a doubles state title in 2013.
